### **Terms & Condition**

1. The candidates need to be aware that this is purely part time job without any regular/ fixed salary on a monthly basis.
2. The DRP are expected to comply with the rules and regulations as laid out in the Scheme Guidelines and perform the assigned duties and responsibilities.
3. Since this is not a regular job, the DRP's should be aware that office space, basic requirements, laptops, gadgets, etc. will not be provided to them at any cost. They are however accountable to the District Commerce & Industries Office who is also the Nodal Officer of the Scheme as and when called.
4. As the DRP will need to travel to various towns/ villages in the district to handhold the beneficiaries, they are to be aware that TA/DA or other allowance will not be provided to them.
