ADVERTISEMENT (GROUP 'C' POSTS)

The under mentioned vacant posts can be applied online on the Mizoram Police Department's online recruitment portal mizopolicerec.com w.e.f. **23.09.2026 to 22.10.2026**. Application shall be submitted in **online mode only**.

Applications which are not successfully submitted shall not be considered, even if payment of the application fee has been made. Applicants are therefore advised to ensure and verify that their application has been successfully submitted even after completion of the payment process.

1. Name of Post : 1. Constable (Unarmed Branch)
2. Constable (Armed Branch)
2. Name of Department : Mizoram Police.
3. Classification : Group 'C'.
4. No. of Posts to be filled up : 1. Constable (Unarmed Branch) - 150 posts
2. Constable (Armed Branch) - 200 posts
5. Pay Scale : Level 2 (₹19,900 - 63,200) in the Pay Matrix.
6. Important instruction for candidates:

A) **General Information:**

- 1) A common online application form shall be used for all categories of posts, whether Unreserved or Reserved category.
- 2) Candidate can apply for more than 1 (one) post (i.e. both UB & AB) but should indicate sequence of his preference.
- 3) A candidate will have an option to apply both in Unreserved category as well as in his/her Reserved category.
- 4) Every candidate shall undergo the four Test/ Exam of the Recruitment namely, (i) Physical Efficiency Test (PET), (ii) Physical Standard Test (PST), (iii) Written Examination, and (iv) Personal Interview.
- 5) Candidates who are applying exclusively under Meritorious Sportspersons category shall undergo Physical Efficiency Test (PET), Physical Standard Test (PST) and Personal Interview. However, he/she will be considered against the posts reserved under the Meritorious Sportspersons category only.
- 6) Applications shall be submitted through the online portal along with all required information and documents specified at 6 (k) within the specified period. However, final screening of documents will be made at the time of personal interview.
- 7) If any candidate is found using false document, wrong information or contracting impersonation at any stage of the recruitment, his/her candidature shall be liable to be cancelled.
- 8) Last date of submission of application in the online portal is **22nd October, 2026.**

- B) **Application Fee:**
₹ 300 for ST/SC candidates and ₹ 400 for General/OBC category candidates to be paid online in the recruitment portal.
- C) **Eligibility Criteria:**
- 1) The candidate must be a citizen of India.
 - 2) The candidate must be a permanent resident of the State of Mizoram provided that the candidate shall also be eligible if his/her parents or any of his/her ancestors in his/her direct lineage are permanent residents of the State, with proper documentary proof like enrolment in Electoral Roll and Birth Certificate (as per GOM Notification No. A.45011/1/2022-P&AR(GSW) Dt.16.05.2025).
 - 3) The candidate must have passed Matriculation or an equivalent examination from a recognized Board or Institution.
 - 4) A candidate who is married must not have more than one living spouse.
 - 5) **Mizo Language Proficiency Test:**
Every candidate including **Ex-Servicemen, MRHG & CD, Women and Meritorious Sportspersons categories**, who has not studied Mizo as a subject in the HSLC Examination or above under the Mizoram Board of School Education (MBSE), or who has not studied Mizo Language as a Modern Indian Language (MIL) under any other Board or University in Class X or above, shall secure the minimum qualifying mark in the Mizo Language Proficiency Test to be conducted in accordance with the Government of Mizoram, Department of Personnel & Administrative Reforms (GSW) Notification vide No. A-11019/1/2021-P&AR(GSW) dated 09.04.2024 published in the Mizoram Gazette, Issue No. 247. (These candidates shall fill up correctly the relevant part in the Application Form on the Recruitment Portal accordingly so that they can be called for the Language Test).

The **Mizo Language Proficiency Test** is a qualifying test and marks obtained in this Test will not be considered for determination of merit list. It will be held after the Physical Standard Test and before the Written Examination. The detailed schedule, venue, and other instructions relating to the said test shall be notified separately on Mizoram Police Website.

 - 6) **Computer Proficiency:**
Every candidate shall possess minimum basic knowledge of computer application equivalent to **Course on Computer Concepts (CCC)** of National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology (NIELIT) or other courses of the level with a minimum of 80 contact hours or its equivalent and above as may be determined by the Government from time to time. The Computer proficiency certificates issued by any institution recognized by All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) or any institution recognized by the State Governments/UT Administration under the Union of India shall be accepted as Computer Proficiency as one of the qualifications for direct recruitment to all Group 'A', 'B' and 'C'. (Notification No.A.12018/31/2020-P&AR(GSW) dt.10.03.2023).
- D) **Educational Qualification/ Other qualification:**
- 1) High School Leaving Certificate (HSLC) or equivalent qualification from a recognized Board or Institution.
 - 2) Candidate(s) applying for the post under the Meritorious Sportsperson Category shall mandatorily possess a valid **Certificate of Eligibility** issued by the Director of Sports & Youth Services, Government of Mizoram.

- 3) Candidate(s) applying for the post under the MRHG & CD category shall possess **Employment Certificate** issued by the head of the office of the MRHG & CD, Govt. of Mizoram.
- 4) Candidate(s) applying for the post under the Ex-servicemen category shall possess '**Ex-Servicemen Certificate**' issued by the head of office of the Sainik Welfare and Resettlement, Govt. of Mizoram.

E)

Age Limit:

- 1) **General Category** : 18 to 28 years (born between 1st August, 1998 to 1st August, 2008) as prescribed by Govt. Notification No.A.60/92/2025-GSW-DPAR dated 10.02.2026.
- 2) **OBC Category** : Upper age limit i.e. 28 yrs relaxable by 3 yrs. (born between 1st August, 1995 to 1st August, 2008)
- 3) **ST/SC Category** : Upper age limit i.e. 28 yrs relaxable by 5 yrs. (born between 1st August, 1993 to 1st August, 2008), as prescribed by Government Notification No.A.12011/1/2019-P&AR(GSW) dated 03.06.2019.
- 4) **MRHG&CD and Woman Candidate** : Same as 1), 2), 3) above as may be applicable according to the category.
- 5) **Ex-Servicemen** : The period of military service shall be deducted from the actual age of the candidate and the resultant age must not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed in 6(E) (1-3) above as the case may be by more than three years, as prescribed by Government Notification No. A.12011/1/2019-P&AR (GSW) dated 03.06.2019 and published in the Mizoram Gazette Extra-Ordinary issued No.375.
- 6) **Meritorious Sportspersons** : Upper age limit i.e. 28 yrs relaxable by 5 yrs for General and 10 yrs for SC/ST as per Govt. OM No.A-12032/1/2019-P&AR(GSW) dated 19.06.2025.

Note:

For age proof document(s), HSLC or Birth Certificate which clearly shows the candidate's date of birth shall be accepted.

Note:

1. The reserved posts for Meritorious Sportspersons category shall be filled up on the basis of mark scored by each candidate in the Personal Interview conducted in accordance with the assessment parameters prepared by the Recruitment Board in line with the order of preference outlined in Para 8 of DP&AR Office Memorandum No. A-12032/1/2029-P&AR(GSW) dated 19.06.2025.
2. If suitable candidates are not available to fill up the posts under any reserved category, the unfilled post(s) in that reserved category shall be pulled for the unreserved category.
3. The candidate under any reserved category can avail the seat under the unreserved category if he/she scores high becoming eligible in the merit list of the unreserved category, provided he/she has not availed any relaxation/concession applicable to that particular reserved category to whom he/she belongs. The resultant seat in the reserved category shall be filled from the next eligible candidate in order of merit in that category.

Physical Efficiency Test (PET):

The Physical Efficiency Test (PET) for the recruitment shall be conducted at the beginning of the Recruitment Test. The detailed schedule and specific dates of test shall be notified separately on Mizoram Police website. All Candidates shall go through the following four Tests viz. 1) Physical Endurance Test, 2) 100 m Race, 3) High Jump, and 4) Long Jump. The prescribed qualifying standards are as follows.

- 1) **Physical Endurance Test :** **1.60 km (1 Mile) Race - for male candidates & 1.00 km Race - for female candidates:**

Note:

- 1) *The qualifying time for male candidates for 1.6 km race shall be 8 minutes and the qualifying time for female candidates for 1.0 km race shall be 7 minutes. Candidates who could not complete the test within this specified time(s) will be disqualified.*
 - 2) *Marks obtained in the Physical Endurance Test (1.60 km race for male & 1.00 km race for female) under Physical Efficiency Test (PET) by each candidate (except under meritorious sportspersons category) shall be taken into account in determining the final marks obtained by the Candidate.*
 - 3) *Physical Endurance Test (1.60 km race for male & 1.00 km race for female) shall be only qualifying in nature for Candidates applying under **Meritorious Sportspersons category** only. However, the mark scored by the sportspersons in the Test shall be taken into account for determination of his/her final score if he/she applies for post under Unreserved/Woman/other quota than Meritorious Sportspersons.*
- 2) **100 m Race, High Jump & Long Jump:** 100 m Race, High Jump and Long Jump in the Physical Efficiency Test (PET) for all candidates shall be conducted solely as qualifying events, with candidates being declared either **Qualified** or **Disqualified**, and that no marks will be awarded for these events. The following shall be qualifying standards for all candidates:-

Only those candidates who qualify in the Physical Efficiency Test (PET) shall be eligible to appear in the Physical Standard Test (PST).

I)

Physical Standard Test (PST):

The Physical Standard Test (PST) for the recruitment shall be conducted as per the following standards. The qualifying standards prescribed for the respective tests are indicated in the table below. All Candidates shall go through the prescribed Test.

There shall not be any minimum weight requirement for female candidates for the present recruitment. Only those candidates who qualified in the Physical Standard Test (PST) shall be eligible to appear in the Written Examination.

J)

Written Examination:

Written Examination for the recruitment is scheduled to be conducted at the three (3) city centres viz. Aizawl, Lunglei and Khawzawl. Specific dates and further details will be provided in due course of time on Mizoram Police Website.

- 1) Written Examination will be conducted in Multiple Choice Question (MCQ) by using Optional Mark Reader (OMR) Answer sheets.
- 2) It will carry 300 marks (100 MCQ with 3 marks each).
- 3) Questions shall be set in English only.
- 4) Questions shall be set in tune with the level of HSLC.
- 5) The Written Examination paper shall comprise of the following subjects, questions, marks and time :

- 6) Candidates who secure 120 marks (40%) or above in the Written Examination only shall be declared Qualified and eligible to appear in the Personal Interview.
- 7) No Written Examination shall be conducted for candidates applying exclusively under the Meritorious Sportspersons Category. However, if the candidate under the Meritorious Sportspersons category desires to apply under the unreserved or Women or MRHG&CD or Ex-servicemen category as may be applicable, he/she shall indicate the same while filling up the application form and shall mandatorily appear in the Written Examination prescribed for the recruitment. The marks so obtained shall be taken into consideration for determination of his/her final score.

K)

Screening of documents:

Screening and verification of original documents shall be conducted at the time of Personal Interview. All candidates shall mandatorily produce the relevant original documents for scrutiny and verification before the Recruitment Board. The following documents shall be produced for screening:

- 1) HSLC Certificate as proof of educational qualification
- 2) Birth Certificate or HSLC Certificate as proof of age.
- 3) Voter ID Card or Aadhaar Card as proof of identity.
- 4) Residential Certificate as proof of residency.
- 5) ST/SC/OBC Certificate (whichever is applicable)
- 6) Certificate of Eligibility for Meritorious Sportspersons Category
- 7) Certificate of Employment for MRHG&CD Employee Category
- 8) Ex-Servicemen Certificate for Ex-Servicemen Category
- 9) Certificate of Computer knowledge (CCC or equivalent & above)
- 10) NCC Certificate (to whomsoever applicable)
- 11) HSLC or above Mark sheet for proof of Mizo Language Proficiency

L) **Personal Interview:**

- 1) Personal Interview shall be conducted in Aizawl only. Specified date and place for eligible candidates will be notified later on the Mizoram Police Website.
- 2) Candidates who qualify (secure 40% or above) in the Written Examination shall be eligible for Personal Interview. However, the number of candidates to be called for Personal Interview (Except under Meritorious Sportsperson category) is fixed at twice the number of vacant posts. In the event of a tie, where two or more candidates secured equal marks and stand at the last position within the limited number of candidates eligible to be called for interview, all such candidates shall be called for the Personal Interview.
- 3) The maximum marks allotted for the Personal Interview shall be 50 (fifty) in respect of all candidates other than that of Meritorious Sportspersons Category.
- 4) In respect of candidates applying under the Meritorious Sportspersons category, the maximum marks for the Personal Interview shall be 100 (one hundred), as no separate Written Examination is prescribed for such candidates. Selection of candidates shall be made on the basis of the mark scored by each candidate in the Personal Interview conducted in accordance with the assessment parameters prepared by the Recruitment Board in line with the order of preference outlined in Para 8 of DP&AR OM No. A-12032/1/2029-P&AR(GSW) dated 19.06.2025. Single Interview Board shall be constituted for Personal Interview under the Meritorious Sportspersons category.
- 5) In cases where the number of applicants for the particular post is less than the number of candidates to be called for Personal interview in that post, Recruitment will be done by means of Personal Interview only as per Para 33(12), Govt. Notification No. A. 12026/1/2017-P&AR (GSW) dated 09.02.2018.

M) **Special Marks for NCC Certificate Holders:**

Special marks shall be awarded to candidates possessing NCC Certificates. The marks shall be added to the overall marks obtained by the candidates, as indicated below:

- 1) NCC 'A' Certificate :1 % of the total marks in written exam.
- 2) NCC 'B' Certificate :2% of the total marks in written exam.
- 3) NCC 'C' Certificate :3% of the total marks in written exam.

7. **Declaration of Selected Candidates:**

List of Selected Candidates for appointment and Reserved Panel in order of merit and category wise shall be prepared on the basis of aggregate of marks (Total Marks) obtained by each candidate in the following Tests/Examination (except those under Meritorious Sportspersons category):

1. Physical Endurance Test (1.6 km race for male & 1.0 km race for female) under Physical Efficiency Test (PET)
2. Written Examination
3. Personal Interview.
4. Marks for NCC Certificate Holder.

In the event of a tie in the merit list of Selected Candidates where two or more candidates secured equal total marks and stand at the last position of the list of Selected Candidates, first preference for offer of appointment shall be given to the eldest among such candidates.

Merit list of Selected Candidates under Meritorious Sportspersons category shall be prepared on the basis of marks obtained in the Personal Interview conducted for them as per para 6 (L)(4) above.

The consolidated list of Selected Candidates and Reserved Panel prepared in order of merit, approved and declared by the competent authority, shall be published on the Mizoram Police Website as well as the official recruitment portal.

8. **Offer of Appointment:**

Letter of Offer of Appointment will be issued to the candidates in the list of Selected Candidates informing them to undergo Medical Examination specifying the date, place and time. Candidates will also be asked in the same letter to submit in writing if they are willing to join the service within a time to be specified in the letter.

In the meantime, concerned District SP will be asked to conduct verification of Character and Antecedent record of the Selected Candidates and to submit the report within a time to be specified in the letter.

9. **Medical Examination:**

All the Selected Candidates shall mandatorily undergo Medical Examination. The Medical Examination shall be conducted by duly qualified Medical Practitioners detailed by the Health & Family Welfare Department for the purpose of determining the medical fitness of the candidate and to ascertain that the Candidate is free from any physical deformity or other condition likely to interfere with the efficient discharge of duties in the Police Force. The detailed schedule, date, time, and venue of the Medical Examination, shall be notified separately on the Mizoram Police Website.

10. **Verification of Character and Antecedents:**

All the Selected Candidates shall undergo verification of Character and Antecedents in accordance with the Government of Mizoram, Department of Personnel & Administrative Reforms (GSW) Office Memorandum No. A-18011/1/2019-P&AR(GSW) dated 27.09.2019. SPs of Districts shall be entrusted to do the verification within a time to be specified.

11. **Disqualification:**

- a) Any form of canvassing, whether direct or indirect, by or on behalf of a candidate shall lead to disqualification of his/her candidature at any stage of the recruitment process.
- b) All particulars and information furnished in the application form shall be complete, accurate, and duly supported by the requisite documents. Applications found incomplete or lacking the required information/documents shall be liable to rejection.
- c) Any candidate using unfair means or forged/fake document shall be disqualified at any stage and appropriate criminal action will be initiated against him/her.

12. **Issue of Appointment order:**

On receipt of written willingness from Selected Candidates supported with flawless Certificate(s) of Medical Examination and Character and Antecedents Verification, the competent authority will issue formal Appointment Order.

13. Government servants shall apply through proper channel.

14. Any other information pertinent to this recruitment will be published on the Mizoram Police website (police.mizoram.gov.in) as well as on dedicated recruitment portal (mizopolicerec.com).
